To be admitted to the Professional Phase of the BLA program beginning of the fourth year, a student must submit an essay on why they wish to be a landscape architect, a portfolio of their design course work for approval and have completed all of the required courses listed on the LA Course Verification form, and have a minimum graduation retention GPA of 2.25.

**Other Requirements:**

A minimum of 40 semester credit hours and 100 grade points must be earned in courses numbered 3000 or above. A 2.00 GPA or higher in upper-division hours. Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation.
